Dear Youth Members:

When you are competing in showmanship, be aware that it is impossible for you to tell the judge "too much". S/he wants to know *everything* you can tell about your bird. Another point is, when reciting the parts of your bird, point to the area/part you say at the same time. Don't just spew out words/terms and point here and there. The judge needs to know that you are labeling the correct part(s) at the correct time. Perhaps some food for thought at all levels of competition.
